Event Cancellation Insurance for community and not-for-profit groups

Why is it important?

Eligibility:

When should you take out Event Cancellation Insurance?



If your community event gets cancelled, postponed or abandoned unexpectedly and beyond your control... Event Cancellation Insurance may help.

Local events take a truckload of time, energy, dedication and money to put on.

A destructive storm, bushfire, or venue issues can cause havoc with your planning or force you to cancel, postpone or cut short your event.

If the worst happens and your event is called off, Event Cancellation Insurance can help cover any financial loss suffered by your organisation as a result.

Community groups invest a lot of time and effort into planning events for their communities, and protecting that investment is crucial.

Event Cancellation Insurance is ideal for events with a budget of \$30,000 or more.

We recommend securing cover as early as possible, ideally 2-3 months in advance.

The Policy requires you to take all reasonable steps to prevent or minimise any potential loss related to cancellation.

If the show can't go on, back your financial investment against these risks:



Adverse weather

Cancellation due to heavy rain, flood, high winds, bushfire, excessive heat, snow, lightning, earthquake, cyclone or extreme weather that affects safety.



People risks

Cancellation due to a key performer being unable to appear due to illness, accident or death.



Venue Risks

Cancellation due to power failure, failure of transport services, inability to setup in preceding days or car parking facilities unusable due to soft grounds.



Political risks

Event cancellation due to civil unrest caused by protests or demonstrators.



Forced event closure

Closure by public authority due to health and safety risk.



Threat/Acts of Terrorism

Event cancellation due to terrorism or bomb threat, including threat or the actual act.

*Note: Excludes communicable or infectious disease, including COVID-19.
